



Down Syndrome Oxfordshire Lottery Rules

1. Each number is £5 per month payable, by a bank transfer on the 1st of the month into the Down Syndrome Oxfordshire's (DSO) allocated bank account.

2. Members may have and are encouraged to have multiple subscriptions.
3. Anybody over 18 years can become a member of the lottery and are encouraged to get family and friends to join. Each member is allocated a number, for each £5 subscription, in the monthly draw. This number shall remain the member's provided their subscription is up to date.
4. A member is eligible for inclusion in the draw if the subscription for that month has been paid into the correct DSO account on the 1st of the month. Payments made on or after the 7th of the month will be entered into the following months draw.
5. There shall be one prize draw per month with at least 3 DSO members present. The draw will take place at a time convenient to the lottery administrator.
6. Monthly prizes will be awarded according for each month as follows:
 - 40% of the month's net payments shall make up the prize fund (Max £200)
 - This will be paid out each month as 3 prizes - 50% First prize (max £100) 30% Second Prize (max £60) and 20% Third Prize (max £40).
 - The remaining 60% of the net payments will be allocated to the Down Syndrome Oxfordshire Charity.
7. The DSO lottery administrator will pay the prize money into the winners' bank accounts.
8. Results will be placed in the newsletter and emailed to all members.
9. The allocation of numbers and draw results will be available on request from the DSO lottery administrator.
10. Members wishing to leave the lottery should stop their monthly payment and advise the lottery administrator.
11. The decision of the Down Syndrome Oxfordshire Trustees shall be final in all matters requiring adjudication.
12. The lottery administrator, with agreement from the DSO trustees, can amend the rules at their discretion. The administrator will also give also reasonable notice to the lottery members of any changes that may affect them.
